## **Campus Security**

Delaware State University?s Office of Public Safety provides for the safety of its students, faculty, and staff. To do this, the University has created a comprehensive, three-tiered security system:

- A fully certified police department, including 18 licensed law enforcement officers with all the powers of any municipal law enforcement agency.
- A fully staffed security force that provides around-the-clock coverage of the 400-acre campus.
- A group of 20-plus Student Cadets, which provides evening escorts, assistance with university events, and extra security within the student population.
