Student Right-to-Know Reporting

The Higher Education Opportunity Act (HEOA) (Sec. 488(a)(3)) states that completion or graduation rates must be disaggregated by:

- recipients of a Federal Pell Grant
- recipients of a subsidized Stafford Loan who did not receive a Pell Grant; and
- recipients who did not receive either a Pell Grant or a subsidized Stafford Loan

Disaggregated 6-year rates for first-time, full-time degree-seeking students are shown below. Cohorts include all full-time, first-time, degree seeking undergraduate students that matriculated at the University in a given fall term. The percent of each cohort that received a baccalaureate degree and time to completion are listed by column.
